Examples:

MANY CHILDREN LIVE HERE.

THERE ARE **MANY** STUDENTS IN THE CLASSROOM.

THERE ARE MANY FRIENDS TO VISIT.

MANY PEOPLE BUY A NEW HOUSE THIS YEAR.

MUCHHOW MUCH

YOU USE THE WORD "MUCH" TO EXPRESS QUANTITY WITH UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS.

HOW MUCH MONEY DO YOU NEED?

HOW MUCH MILK DO YOU DRINK?

III.-LOOK AT THESE EXPLANATIONS:

THE WORD MANY IS USED + COUNTABLE NOUNS

THE WORD MUCH IS USED + UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS.

THE WORD A LOT OF :IS USED + COUNTABLE OR UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS.

EXAMPLES:

MANY STUDENTS HAVE A PET.

I DON'T HAVE MUCH TIME FOR GYM.

HE NEEDS A LOT OF MONEY TO LIVE.

THERE ARE A LOT OF PEOPLE IN THE CLASSROOM.

HERE THERE ARE A LOT OF GAMES

A LOT OF STUDENTS WEAR JEANS.

THERE ARE A LOT OF CHILDREN AT THE GYM.

SHOULD IS USED TO GIVE ADVICE. (SHOULD SIRVE PARA DAR CONSEJO)

EXAMPLES:

YOU SHOULD STUDY A LOT IF YOU WANT TO BE A GOOD STUDENT.

YOU SHOULD GO TO THE GYM IF YOU WANT TO BE ON SHAPE.

THE VERB SHOULD IS AN AUXILIARY VERB THAT YOU USE WITH ANOTHER VERB.

SHOULD + VERB

YOU SHOULD BE

YOU SHOULD GO

YOU SHOULD STUDY

YOU SHOULD RUN

COMPLETE THE CORRECT VERB.

SHOULDN'T IS THE SAME WORD IN NEGATIVE FORM-

VI. THE USE OF "DO" OR "DOES"

DO AND DOES ARE AUXILIARY VERBS THAT YOU USE WHEN YOU ASK A QUESTION.

YOU USE "DO" WITH SOME PERSONAL PRONOUNS LIKE: I--WE---YOU---THEY-

YOU USE "DOES" WITH SOME PERSONAL PRONOUNS LIKE: SHE--HE---IT-

EXAMPLES:

DO YOU SPEAK ENGLISH?

DO WE LIKE CHOCOLATES?

DO I DO MY HOMEWORK?

DO THEY READ A BOOK?

DOES SHE LIKE ANIMALS?

DOES HE PLAY THE PIANO?

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
