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UNIT 1 "JOBS"

AIM: nivel 1/ OA 8

1. Señalar frecuencia, grado y tiempo de acciones; por ejemplo:

he has worked here since 2010; He has worked here for 10 years. I studied French five years ago; I studied French last year. I go to the bank once a month; I go to the school every days.

2.-.-• Solicitar y dar información sobre duración de una actividad; por ejemplo:

How long have you studied? / (since/for).-

we have studied **since** yesterday. La palabra **since** marca el inicio de una actividad.

I have danced since yesterday.

We have studied **for** 5 hours. La palabra **for** marca un período de tiempo.

I have danced for 2 hours.

I.-HOW OFTEN DO YOU DO THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES? (FOLLOW THE EXAMPLES). Son acciones del presente.



EXAMPLES:

- 1.- How often **do** you **read** a book? I read a book **twice a month**, a week, a day, a year.
- 2.- how often **do** you **go** to the cinema? I go to the cinema **on Saturdays**. On Mondays. On Tuesdays.
- 3.- how often do you visit your grandparents? I visit my grandparents once a week.
- 4.- how often **do** you **play** the guitar? I play the guitar **every days.**
- 5.- how often **do** you **listen** to the music? I listen to the music **three times a week.**

ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS USING:

ONCE A WEEK, TWICE A WEEK, THREE TIMES, ON SATURDAYS, ON MONDAYS, ON TUESDAY, IN SUMMER, IN WINTER, IN SPRING, EVERY DAYS. These are expressions that indicate the frequency of an action.-

4 How often do you go to the dentist? go to the dentist once a year
5 How often do you play football? play football once a week
6 how often do you eat fast food?
7 how often do you cal l your friends?
8 how often do you watch TV?
9 how often do you listen to the music?
10 how often do you play video games?
11 How often do you go to the beach?

REMEMBER:

In the answer you write the verb in simple present and you add an expression like:

Once a week, una vez a la semana. Twice a week, dos veces a la semana, three times a week tres veces a la semana, every days: todos los días. On Saturdays: los sábados.



II.- WHEN DID YOU DO THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS? FOLLOW THE EXAMPLES: son acciones del pasado.-

EXAMPLES:

- 1.- When did you study English? I studied English last Monday.
- 2.- When did you play football? I played football last night.
- 3.- When did you visit your children? I visited my children last week.

"To complete your answer you put the verb in past tense and you add a past tense expression."

Look: simple past tense expressions:

Last Saturday, last Friday, last week, last month, last year, last summer, last winter, yesterday.

Verbs in past tense.

Simple present	Simple past
I work	I worked
l listen	I listened
I walk	I walked
I dance	I danced
I love	I loved
I study	I studied
l like	I liked
I enjoy	I enjoyed
I played	I played
I watch	I watched
l look	I looked
I finish	I finished
I fix	I fixed
I prefer	I preferred
I want	I wanted
l answer	I answered
I describe	I described
I discover	I discovered
I support	I supported
I admire	I admired
I start	I started

IV.- THE USE OF: SINCE AND FOR: THERE ARE WORDS TO SPEAK IN PAST TENSE WHEN THE ACTIVITY STARTED IN THE PAST AND CONTINUE IN THE PRESENT.

THE WORD "SINCE" INDICATES THE TIME WHEN YOU STARTED AN ACTION:

Examples:

I have studied since yesterday

I have danced since this morning

I have played the piano since last night.

THE WORD "FOR" INDICATES A PERIOD OF TIME:

Examples:

She has studied for 3 hours

She has danced for 3 days

She has worked for 3 years.



THEY HAVE PLAYED FOOTBALL SINCE THIS MORNING

V.- ANSWER THE QUESTIONS USING THE FOLLOWING EXPRESSIONS.

For two hours - for two months ---for five hours---since yesterday—since this morning--since last year----since yesterday.

1How long have you worked here? I have worked herefor two years
2 How long have you studied ? I have studiedsince yesterday
